

## APPLICATION FOR CUNDERDIN LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Our 1.4 million members perform valuable service in 210 countries and geographic areas around the globe. Lions are friends, family and neighbours who share a core belief: community is what we make it.

The Cunderdin Lions Club Scholarship is an exclusive scholarship to the value of \$2,250 to fund a voyage on the STS Leeuwin II in 2017/2018.

This scholarship is born out of a desire to play a role in the lives of young members of the Cunderdin community, and to help those people fulfil their opportunities and potential. This Scholarship is intended for a young proactive individual aged 15 – 24 years old, who has leadership potential and is ready to embrace personal challenge.

The successful candidate will take part in a week-long voyage on the STS Leeuwin II, run by not-for-profit organisation the Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation. You will join up to 39 other young people aged 14-25 from all walks of life and backgrounds and get involved in every aspect of sailing the ship. The successful candidate will be required to give a presentation to the Cunderdin Lions Club after completing their voyage, submit their voyage journal (provided on the ship) and act as an ambassador promoting the scholarship and experience to future interested participants in your community.

Voyages include programs designed to help young people build skills such as self-confidence, communication, team work and leadership which are often necessary to obtain and make the most of future education and employment. Added to this, the Curriculum Council of Western Australia has endorsed Leeuwin voyages of five nights or more as a suitable program for youth in years 10, 11 & 12 to assist with 1 unit towards their Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE).

- 5. Any images, video footage or testimonials of applicants can be used by the Foundation or its partners for any promotional purposes.
- 6. The Club may withdraw the scholarship at any time
- 7. All applicants must be actively engaged in educational studies **or** employed **or** actively seeking employment.
