

To apply for a Woodside Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. He/she is between 14 and 25 years of age when the voyage departs.
2. He/ she has a home address within the Roebourne, Karratha, Broome, Exmouth or Perth Metropolitan areas.
3. All relevant sections of the scholarship form are completed.
4. If a scholarship is granted the applicant will need to fill out a medical and application form which will to be assessed by the Foundation for final approval.
5. The applicant's contribution towards the voyage fare will need to be paid in full to the Foundation 60 days before the voyage departs.
6. Any images, video footage or testimonials of applicants can be used by the Foundation or its partners for any promotional purposes.
7. The Foundation may withdraw the scholarship at any time.
8. All applicants must be actively engaged in educational studies or employed or actively seeking employment.
9. Successful applicants will receive a scholarship towards the cost of a Leeuwin Ocean Adventure - Youth Explorer Voyage.
10. The Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation will inform applicants directly on whether the Scholarship has been approved.
11. Please complete a scholarship form for each applicant. Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation will be the principal determinant of successful scholarship recipients.
12. Scholarships must be used before June 2018.
