

Who are we?

The Leeuwin Foundation aims to enrich the lives of young people through adventure, participation and challenge.

The Leeuwin Foundation is a trusted not-for-profit organisation based in Fremantle. Since 1986 we have welcomed more than 40,000 young people onboard the STS Leeuwin II.

The Leeuwin Foundation is funded through a combination of grants, corporate sponsorships and donations by organisations and the general public.





The ship

STS Leeuwin II is a three-masted sail training ship designed in an 1850's barquentine style. The ship was launched in 1986.

It is 55 metres long and 33 metres tall. It has 16 sails with a total of 810m² of canvas.

On each voyage the ship can accommodate 40 trainees plus 15 crew members (ten volunteers and five professional crew).

Why you need a Will

A will is the best way to ensure that your personal wishes are honoured.

Preparing a Will

Ideally, you should consult an independent legal advisor, such as a solicitor or trustee, to ensure your will reflects your wishes and meets and complies with Western Australian legislation.

Types of Bequests



A gift of your estate. After you have made payment of debts, expenses, legacies and taxes from your estate, you chose to donate what remains to Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation Ltd. This is known as a Residual (Whole) Bequest



A cash gift. This is when you leave an exact and specific sum of money to Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation Ltd. This is known as a Pecuniary Bequest.



A specific gift. This is donation of an item of personal property such as jewelry, stocks and bonds. This is known as a Specific Bequest.



A percentage gift. After you have made payment of debts, expenses, legacies and taxes from your estate, you chose to donate a percentage of what remains to Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation Ltd. This is known as a Residual (Percentage) Bequest.



A living bequest. Gifting your bequest now rather than update a will. See immediately what a difference your gift can make to our organisation.

Making a Bequest to the

To make a bequest to the Foundation, we suggest the following wording:

I give to Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation Limited (ABN 65 009 105 677) of B-Berth Peter Hughes Drive Victoria Quay Fremantle Western Australia 6160

Either:


- a) its general purposes, or
