APPLICATION FOR A MARINE CAREER SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for three deserving young people in Geraldton (aged 14-25) who wish to participate on a Leeuwin Youth Explorer Voyage. This scholarship aims to assist anyone with an interest in a career in the marine environment or maritime industry and have financial limitations preventing them from being able to attend a Leeuwin voyage.

The Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation operates 7 day/6 night voyages on the sailing vessel *STS Leeuwin II* primarily for young Western Australians. Voyages cater for individuals from all walks of life and backgrounds.

Voyages include programs designed to help young people build skills such as self-confidence, communication, team work and leadership which are often necessary to obtain and make the most of future education and employment.

Added to this, the Curriculum Council of Western Australia has endorsed Leeuwin voyages of 5 nights or more as a suitable program for youth in years 10, 11 & 12 to earn 5 points towards their Western Australian Certificate of Education, which is equivalent to one semester of study in one subject (endorsed as a Personal Development or Outdoor/ Physical Education program).

The full fare for a voyage on the STS Leeuwin II is \$2,250 for the 2016/17 sailing season. Scholarships from an anonymous donor cover up to \$1125 leaving \$1125 (minimum) to be covered by the applicant or other sponsors. The voyage fare covers: sail training program, all meals on-board, use of wet weather gear, any shore visits (weather permitting), accommodation on-board.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To apply for a Marine Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. He/She is actively involved is older than 14 and not older than 25 when the voyage departs.
2. He/She has an interest in a career in the maritime industry or marine environment.
3. He/She is available for voyage 1705, 1706 or 1707.
4. All relevant sections of the scholarship form are completed.
5. If a scholarship is granted the applicant will need to fill out a medical and application form which will to be assessed by the Foundation for final approval.
6. The applicant's contribution towards the voyage fare will need to be paid in full to the Foundation 60 days before the voyage departs.
7. Any images, video footage or testimonials of applicants can be used by the Foundation or its partners for any promotional purposes.
8. The Foundation may withdraw the scholarship at any time.
9. Successful applicants will receive a scholarship to offset costs incurred in attending the Leeuwin Ocean Adventure - Youth Explorer or Open Explorer voyages.
10. The Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation will inform applicants directly on whether the Scholarship has been approved.
11. Please complete the attached form for each applicant. The staff of the Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation will be the principal determinant of successful scholarship recipients.
