



APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING

Fully funded by **RMD Tankers** and supported by the **Rockingham Kwinana Chamber of Commerce** a scholarship is available to a deserving young person from the Rockingham area who wishes to participate on a Leeuwin Youth Explorer Voyage in 2017/18.

The Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation, based in Fremantle, operates 7 day/6 night Youth Explorer voyages on the tall-ship sailing vessel STS Leeuwin II for young Western Australians between the ages of 14 and 25. Voyages are suitable for individuals from all walks of life and backgrounds.

The voyage program is designed to assist young people to build skills such as self-confidence, communication, team participation and team leadership – all of which are critical to obtaining and making the most of education and employment opportunities.

For school age participants, the School Curriculum and Standards Authority has endorsed Leeuwin Youth Explorer voyages as a suitable program for young people in years 10, 11 & 12 to earn 5 points towards their Western Australian Certificate of Education, which is equivalent to one semester of study in one subject (endorsed as a Personal Development or Outdoor/ Physical Education program).

The scholarship will cover: the sail training program, all accommodation and meals, use of wet weather gear, shore visits (weather permitting) and a 12 month membership (which provides access to the Leeuwin volunteering program and other benefits).

Eligibility for a scholarship is assessed on the information provided by applicants via the attached form.

3. You have shown a commitment to your personal development.
4. You have completed all relevant sections of the scholarship form.

If you are successful in securing the scholarship:

5. You will fill out an application and medical form which will be assessed by the Foundation for final approval. You will receive confirmation directly from the Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Foundation on whether the scholarship has been approved
6. Any images, video footage or testimonials from your participation on the voyage can be used by the sponsor, the Foundation or their partners for promotional purposes.
7. The Foundation may in its absolute discretion withdraw the scholarship at any time.

Your scholarship may only be used to support your participation on a Leeuwin Ocean Adventure Youth Explorer or Open Explorer voyage.
